Camp Rules – KEEP For Your Records

Campers are Expected to:

- 1. Always stay on the campground. Plan to stay at camp all week.
- 2. Obey all camp staff.
- 3. Respect others and camp property by REFRAINING from the following:
 - a. Using Foul and/or Disrespectful Language
 - b. Writing on walls or destroying camp property
 - c. Fighting, scuffling, or horseplay
 - d. Stealing
 - e. Improper conduct between campers
 - f. Disruptive behavior during activities and meals
 - g. Placing trash anywhere but a trash receptacle
- 4. Not bring or possess Prohibited items:
 - a. Cell Phones, or Any Electronic Devices
 - b. Food & Drinks
 - c. Matches, Lighters, or any Ignition Sources
 - d. Tobacco and/or Vaping products
 - e. Drugs / Alcohol
 - f. Weapons of any kind
- 5. Get up when your counselor wakes you each morning and arrive on time for all meals and activities.
- 6. Stay with your counselor when walking to and from meals and activities.
- 7. Attend and participate in all activities (including recreation and surprise hour).
- 8. Stay out of the kitchen. It is off limits to campers.
- 9. Obey lifeguards and/or staff at the water time. Failure to do so will result in loss of water swimming privileges.
- 10. Tell a counselor or coach if you are not feeling well or if you get hurt during an activity.
- 11. Visit camp nurse only with permission from your counselor.
- 12.Dress in attire that is modest and free of offensive texts or graphics. (No spaghetti straps or low necklines.) Activity clothing can be worn except during evening service.
 - Water time: Clothing must be worn over a bathing suit when traveling to and from the water area.
- 13.Clean up! NGM prides itself on keeping a clean facility. Campers are expected to participate in cabin clean-up and to dispose of all trash appropriately (especially at Canteen). The "Cleanest Group" will receive an award.
- 14. Use camp mail as it is intended, for encouraging purposes.
- 15.Be Quiet after lights out!

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
